Electoral Roll

This year sees the renewal of the Parish / Church Electoral Roll. This means that no names are carried forward from the current roll and everyone, who wishes to, <u>must</u> apply to go on the new Electoral Roll.

The application forms are currently available in Church. If you wish to be on the Electoral Roll, please make sure you **complete a form** and put it into the marked box or pass it to your Electoral Roll Officer **by Sunday 24**th **February.**

If anyone wants to stand for election to the offices of Churchwarden and/or PCC / DCC member, then you have to be entered onto the roll for at least 6 months before nomination. Not being on the Church Electoral Roll also affects your eligibility to vote at the AGM, Meeting of Parishioners and Annual Parochial Church Meeting and on some PCC and DCC decisions.
