



The Marriage Preparation Course is an opportunity for you to grow and learn together as a couple.

The course is set in a relaxed atmosphere whilst listening to practical talks that are informative and fun, either given live or played on DVD. There is no group work and you will never be asked to share anything about your relationship with anyone other than your partner.

We ask that you book on to a course as soon as possible by either contacting the parish office or talking to whoever is taking your service (the dates of the next course can be found overleaf). We ask for a contribution of £50 per couple towards the cost of running the course (payable at the time of booking).

The course looks at topics such as commitment, recognising your differences, communication, developing a good sexual relationship and developing shared values and goals.
