SUNDAY 10th JANUARY

A Message from your Clergy

Once again we face testing times, but we seek to face them together. In the light of recent announcements by the Prime Minister of a further national lockdown Robert and I have decided that we should close our churches for communal worship for the month of January (except for funerals) in order to keep safe and serve the community as best we can. We will review the decision later this month to decide what to do in February. In making this decision we have taken into account the Prime Minister's urgency in bringing in the national lockdown, the closure of schools, the tightening of Christmas restrictions, and the general call to reduce the number of contacts we have with each other. Covid-19 is a quickly spreading virus and we want to play our part in reducing the opportunities for it to spread, and to prevent further pressure being placed on the NHS. With vaccines now available let us hope this closure will end, sooner rather than later. However you feel about this decision let's make the most of the opportunities of staying connected together as churches. The online service continues to meet at 11:00am each Sunday, and we have re-introduced the contrasting quieter and more traditional online service at 6:30pm each Sunday during January. Other opportunities to meet online for prayer, as well as how to join these services, are detailed elsewhere in this newsletter, plus all the other resources that are available ([YouTube channel](#), [Facebook page](#), etc) In addition, let's express our fellowship together as churches by each of us doing what we can to keep in touch especially with those who are on their own. Let's continue to pray for each other and offer support where it is safe to do so. We can still be confident that our God is with us, even in the midst of this messy pandemic. Let's keep safe and also seek to shine as lights for Christ, sharing his love and hope wherever we can.

Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 8th January

“What is this thing called Love?” is a song from the past, and our passages this week give us a precise answer for the question “What does God think Love is?” There is a clarity here that Love starts with God; he is the origin of it, and it does not come to us merely in words, but in action – the sacrificial action of Jesus. “Our love for God” is simply a reflection of and reaction to “his love for us”. And it doesn’t stop in that two-way street: we are urged to show our love for God is real by loving others in the same way. It’s a big challenge, but praise God he offers us his Spirit to make it possible!
