## National Day of Reflection - Tuesday 23rd March

To mark the anniversary of the first lockdown, next Tuesday has been designated by the **Church of England**, in conjunction with the charity **Marie Curie**, as a special day to reflect on the collective loss and grief of the millions who have been bereaved since the start of the Covid-19 pandemic. Your clergy have penned the following prayer:

God of Love, as we think about all that has changed this year, help us to trust that you are always with us. As we remember those who have died in the faith of Christ, help us to trust they are at peace with you. Keep us from mourning as if there were no hope as we reach out to others with kindness and care, and may Christ's peace shine out in every heart and home. Amen

There will be a minute's silence at 12:00noon to **Reflect** on the last 12 months; you could reach out and **Connect** with someone you know who is bereaved and you can 'Share the Light' at 8:00pm by lighting a candle or lantern and displaying it in your window to show your **Support**. ## **Easter Services and reopening of Churches**

Some churches will reopen for in-person services this Easter. We will still need to follow the Covid-19 guidelines, however, we do not intend to operate a booking system.

Good Friday (2<sup>nd</sup> April): 10:00am Online Service for all ages, with St Cassian's team. 2:00pm Online Service "Hour at the Cross" with readings, music and prayer.

Easter Sunday (4<sup>th</sup> April): 9:30am at St Cassian's, Service of Holy Communion.

11:00am at St George's, Service of Holy Communion.

**11:00am Online Service** with sharing of Bread & Wine and singing Easter hymns.

## Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 19th March

In the midst of reading Jeremiah we pause to celebrate the feast day of 'Joseph of Nazareth', step-dad to Jesus. We are familiar in Jeremiah hearing that God's ancient people face the coming punishment of exile because of their rebellion against him, their refusal to remain true to him; now here in Matthew we hear of the coming rescue in the birth of Jesus for God's people, which is now a group much widened and extended. In both books the message was unexpected. In both places it was questioned. Praise God that in Matthew, Joseph chooses to respond obediently to the message he receives. Is there a choice we must make?
