(Please see electoral roll notice below). Churchwardens for St Chad's & St Cecilia's (deputies) are currently ratified by the Churchwardens for the other 3 churches. Please note social distancing measures will be in place and all attendees, unless exempt, will be required to wear a face covering. There will be a limit of 100 attendees in order to meet current restrictions. The Agenda & supporting papers have been sent out via Mailchimp and, for those without internet access, there are a few printed copies of the papers available in the 5 churches. Please notify the Parish Office if any further (or large print) copies are required.
