Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 3rd September

Mark 8:29 is understood to be a watershed moment in the gospel. Up until this point Jesus has been showing the disciples and the crowds who he is. Peter gets it right, "You are the Christ, the Messiah". From that moment on Jesus begins to teach them what it means for him to be the Messiah; it will mean his death – but that's not the end of the story. The disciples don't immediately understand (there is hope for us all!): Peter gets it wrong; the 12 get it wrong. But the father of the boy in today's reading is on track, "I do believe; help me overcome my unbelief!" Who's example shall we follow?

Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 10th September

By this stage the disciples have heard Jesus tell them about his forthcoming death three times (chapters 8, 9 and 10) and they still find it hard to grasp what Jesus has come to do. Even James and John (two of the 'inner group' of three, along with Peter) start making inappropriate requests about seating plans. We wouldn't have been any better, and their lack of clarity becomes another opportunity for Jesus to explain his ministry: he's going to pay a ransom that is impossible for us to pay, so that we can be set free. Is there anything better (e.g. seating plans) than knowing we have the freedom not just of the city but of the Kingdom?
