Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 19th August

1 Samuel 22. In this part of the Old Testament we read about the transition of power from the first king of Israel, Saul, to the second king, David. The two had become very close: David had married one of Saul's daughters, but was it a matter of "familiarity breeds contempt"? Saul had become envious of David's military victories and the praise he received for them, and it was murderous envy. Should David lead a rebellion or encourage a mutiny? No, instead he gives us a Godly example (in the next few day's readings) of how to respect authority whilst not condoning its ungodly agenda. Is this of help for our journey through life?

Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 26th August

2 Samuel 1. It was a turbulent time as Saul's reign came to an end. From a merely

human point of view it might be seen as victory for the underdog, David, who could now rightfully claim what was due to him, that for which he had been anointed when he was a shepherd boy some years before. From a human point of view the young Amalekite, who was deserting the defeated enemy of Israel and wanted to support David, appeared to think that as the "enemy of David's enemy" (i.e. murderer of Saul) this would curry favour. David's judgement of this man brings us up short to remember that we do not live our lives only from "a human point of view".
