Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 3rd February

The chapters in this week's readings are some of the 'big hitters' that we often turn to first when thinking about spiritual gifts, the analogy of the church being the body of Christ, love, and orderly worship. The chapter about resurrection is being set aside until

nearer Easter! With all of these themes Paul is addressing an issue that had arisen in the Corinthian church, and his words are still relevant for us even where the issue is not as pressing as it was for them. However, this letter is not a theological textbook, and that is made clear in the final chapter where Paul refers to individuals by name and the contribution they have made to the ministry of the gospel. Which is the name or phrase that encourages you the most? Which phrase would you like to have been written about you? What can you do to make that true?

Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 10th February

This week we have been with Jesus and his last few days of ministry before crucifixion; we have heard ourselves being prayed for in his detailed prayer in chapter 17, and now

we might find our reactions reflected in the actions of Peter and others. At the arrest of Jesus Peter appears to want to stop it from happening by striking out with the sword: do we get confused as to whether it's sad news or good news that Jesus was taken? And then Peter loses his nerve when he is challenged about being a disciple of Jesus: do we let fear or shame get the better of us sometimes? The official strikes out at Jesus as words of truth are given in answer to their questions: do his words always draw the appropriate reaction from us? Thank God for the grace of Jesus in all these encounters.
