
Lent Course 2023

Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd Robert Legge for Friday 3rd March

Jeremiah 6 v 22-30: How many times have you found yourself in the embarrassing position of only hearing half of a story, acting upon that half and then making a gigantic mess of the subsequent outcome? I certainly have and quite often it is the people

closest to me who have had to step in and help me to sort it all out! I think that what we need to remember is that it isn't a question of the half story being wrong as such, it's just incomplete and therefore we don't get the full sense as to what is really happening. And that's what happens in this passage. Everything written here is true; the Assyrians are going to invade and capture Israel in 723BC and the Babylonians will do the same to Judah in 586BC. However that's only one part of the story. As we will see in a few weeks' time a remnant of the people of Judah will remain and return to Jerusalem and God's plan for His people will

need to hear God's story in its entirety. We need to pay attention to His warnings as well
as His blessings, His challenges as well as His encouragements. And we need to
respond to both in love and in gratitude.

Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd Robert Legge for Friday 10th March

Jeremiah 10 v 1-16: I don't know what many of you do in your spare time, however I will take a wild guess that few if any of you go into the forest, cut down a tree, shape it with your chisel, adorn it with silver and gold and fasten it with hammer and nails! In our modern times we find it frankly incomprehensible that people could do such a thing;

create gods that are really no gods at all, but half a moment! Are there any gods that we fashion today albeit in a slightly different form? What about the gods of money, popularity, influence, comfort, status and possessions to name but a few? These are the things our world tends to worship and idolise and there is always a danger that consciously or unconsciously we join in with them. Before we condemn the people of the Old Testament too harshly let us look into our own hearts and see if there are any gods lurking there that have much more influence in our lives than we might care to admit.
