WHO CAN GET MARRIED AT ST GEORGE'S?

Any adult can marry at St George's if they either

- Live within the parish boundaries of the church
- Have a legal connection with the Parish
- Or who have attended the church regularly at any time for at least six months



WHAT NEXT

Most couples are keen to set the date of the wedding. If you are looking to have your wedding on a specific date then do contact us as soon as possible. Please note that days get booked up years in advance! We will want to meet you for an informal chat (please telephone the Parish Office on 01562 822131).

If there are no problems we will offer you a date and time for your wedding service which we will hold for **two weeks pending the deposit**. If

we do not hear back from you the wedding date may be given to someone else. The wedding is booked once we have received a **£100 deposit** and we will send you a letter to confirm your booking and remind you what you need to do next.

WHAT IF I HAVE BEEN MARRIED BEFORE?

It is the preference of the clergy of the Parish of Kidderminster East not to conduct weddings where a previous marriage has ended in divorce and the ex-spouse is still alive.

However, we do want to celebrate new beginnings and would be happy to discuss, as an alternative, a church service of Blessing, Prayer and Dedication shortly after your Civil Ceremony.

For some couples this might be a quieter service with just a few guests, whereas other couples may wish to include bells, organ and choir with many guests in attendance.

BANNS OF MARRIAGE

Banns of marriage have to be read at the parish church where you live. If either of you don't live in the Parish of Kidderminster East, it is vital that **you** contact the vicar of the parish church where either of you live a few months before your wedding. If you move, please check with us what you need to do. **IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO GET THE BANNS CERTIFICATE FROM THE VICAR (FOR WHICH YOU WILL HAVE TO PAY A FEE). OTHERWISE WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO GO AHEAD WITH THE SERVICE!**

PREPARING FOR MARRIED LIFE

Your next step is to book on to a Marriage Preparation Course which is essential for all couples who want to get married at St George's. The course is a chance amongst all the plans for your big day to prepare for married life! We ask for a contribution of just £25 per couple towards the cost of running the course (payable at time of booking).

The aim of The Marriage Preparation Course is to help couples lay the foundations for a relationship that will last a lifetime

PLANNING THE WEDDING SERVICE

We will meet with you a couple of months before the wedding day to advise you what is possible and to ensure that all the parts of the service are in place. In the meantime feel free to look around for ideas of what you would like in the service.

THE ORDER OF SERVICE

We will discuss what happens in each part of the service. Generally it follows the outline shown here.

There are some parts of the service that can be changed according to your taste and some parts that have to stay the same.

- The music in the service
- The readings in the service
- Who will witness the signing of the marriage document

We are very happy to discuss ideas you have for the service and are keen where possible to make the service personal for you and your families.

ORDER of SERVICE You may want to produce a printed order of service (we will need to check this before printing) or alternatively you can use the church hymn books.

MUSIC IN THE SERVICE

You will want to have music as the bride enters the church during the signing of the registers and at the end of the service as well as two or three hymns. For suggestions of hymns other than those shown here see rscm.com/wedding

The church choir is generally available to sing at weddings and helps to lead the hymns. Please note, providing a choir mid-week may not always be possible.

Whether you want the Bridal March or other music during the service you will need to discuss this with the Clergy.

There will be a Bible reading in the service. You might also want to consider if you would like to choose a poem or other reading.

FLOWERS FOR THE SERVICE

Most weeks there are flowers arranged in church. You may want to supply your own flowers as well. Please note that only biodegradable confetti is allowed and this must be used away from the church entrance. Scattering petals in or outside church is not allowed.

BELLS

If you would like the church bells to be rung for your wedding service then please discuss this with the Clergy.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND VIDEO

Photography and video recording can be very distracting during a wedding service. If you are keen to have photographs taken or video recorded we are very happy to discuss how this may be possible.

THE COST OF YOUR WEDDING

There are the same basic fees for every wedding. On top of these fees there are charges that depend on choices you make. For example you can choose whether you want an organist, bell ringing and the choir (subject to availability).

The table below sets out the costs for wedding taking place in **2026**. We will confirm what the costs will be for your service.

Weddings taking place in **2027** and later will be subject to increases. We will inform you of these as soon as we are able.

A FINAL NOTE ON TIMINGS

Weddings generally last around 45 minutes. We expect the bride to arrive on time, so that there are a few minutes for photographs on arrival. There may be other weddings or events taking place that day. Where the bride arrives late there may be no time to take photographs on arrival, and the service may need to be shortened, e.g. taking out a hymn, etc.
