Deuteronomy 29. There are blessings for obedience and curses for disobedience during God's formation of his People into the holy nation that will carry his blessing to

others. The covenant, pact or agreement that we read about is what we now refer to as the Old Covenant, since there is a New Covenant that is offered to us through faith in Jesus. The result of the covenants is the same: God's holy people busy with his holy mission. The ancient People of God couldn't keep their side of the covenant (obedience), and let's not think we would have done any better! The New Covenant is fuelled and filled with the grace of Jesus as he supplies what we are lacking, as he takes away our

sinfulness and replaces it with his holiness. Are we ready to get on with his mission?




Bible Reading group

Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 2nd June

Romans 3. Paul is writing to the Christians in Rome as they come to understand that

they are welcomed into being the People of God through faith in Jesus. Far from undermining all that happened in the Old Testament, Jesus has fulfilled and brought to new life all that it was pointing to. Some of Paul's reasoning needs careful reading (slowly and a number of times!) but keep in mind that these people in Rome, just like us, are loved by God (1:7) and have faith in Jesus (1:8). It is that faith which opens the way to the Father whether we are of Jewish or non-Jewish heritage: all have sinned, and all are justified freely by his grace. Alleluia!
