Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 4th August

Jeremiah 35. A new covenant is going to be made between God and his people (the Old is described in Jer 11:4) such that God will forgive and forget (31:34). As a sign of this hope, in the midst of the overrunning of their land Jeremiah is told by God to buy a field, since one day that field will be fully his again. The people and the land will be restored, after this period of exile and punishment: God's great desire is for his people to turn to him in repentance and faith, and to show that by their obedience. This is why the Recabites are honoured. They are a small family who have kept the command they were given. We have the new covenant, the promises of God, his enduring love, his hope of a secure future, his word delivered to us: from this week's chapters whose example shall we follow?

Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 11th August

Jeremiah 39. Today we read of the fall of Jerusalem into the hands of the Babylonians, all of which has been long forewarned as the judgement of God against his people. Earlier this week we read of the desperate attempt of the king to silence God's word by burning it piece by piece: he could not succeed. And then came the attempt to silence God's messenger: that could not succeed either. Instead, the Lord's message and messenger prevailed, and Ebed-Melech, who shows kindness to Jeremiah is given his own private message of rescue. No matter how much the people and their leaders sought to rail against God's word, that word remained God's intention for his people: and it was his intention to reform and renew his people.

Mark is currently rector of Kempsey & Severn Stoke with Croome d'Abitot & Norton as well as Area Dean of Malvern and Upton. He will succeed Archdeacon Robert Jones who is retiring at the end of November. Read more...
