Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 22nd November

Daniel 10. This section of the book of Daniel is quite an unusual read. It is almost as if Daniel sees behind the scenery of the stage of this world and is shown what is going on in the spiritual world which determines what happens on the stage. He makes a link with the book of the prophet Jeremiah, and refers to Gabriel (who appears in the Christmas story) and to Michael (who appears in the Book of Revelation), which might just help us to see this is not absolutely beyond our understanding, but stands in the flow of Scripture that says the King of kings is coming, and his kingdom lasts for ever, no matter what the political scenery of the world looks like in any particular Act.

Isaiah 41. It's a big prophecy to get a handle on, but here in this part of the book of Isaiah we are encouraged to ponder the immensity of our God, his vastness, his infinity, such that he is more than any match for any situation we face. The prophet points out how often we settle for gods that are less than nothing: idols, models, made in our own image. Instead we are called to wonder at the grace the Almighty God shows us and how that is brought to us through the one called his 'servant'. He comes to lift up, to restore, and as we enter the season of Advent we know that his name is Jesus!

The independent review by Keith Makin into the Church of England's handling of allegations of serious abuse by the late John Smyth (which subsequently led to the resignation of Archbishop Justin Welby) has been published. Our deanery proposed a motion to the Diocesan Synod about <u>Sustainable Church</u> <u>Flowers</u>, which was adopted. Churches are encouraged to refrain from the use of floral foam (Oasis) in arrangements and to source flowers locally wherever possible.
