Faithful Friday Blog Post from The Ven Andy Piggott for Friday 25th October

We've read this week more of Paul's encouraging words to Timothy. About 20 years ago when I was leaving my role at the Church Pastoral Aid Society and preparing to move to a new ministry, a group of colleagues with whom I'd worked closely for the previous 4+ years gathered round me to pray and commend me to God's care and keeping. It was a very affirming and positive experience, and has proved to be a very memorable one. As they prayed, one of them read words from Paul to Timothy that we'll have come across this week "... I remind you to fan into flame the gift of God, which is in you For God did not give us a spirit of timidity, but a spirit of power, of love and of self-discipline" (1:6,7).

Paul was well aware of Timothy's capacity for self-doubt and that from time to time he lacked confidence. He wanted to remind Timothy that God had both called him and would equip him for service. The same of course is true for us! May God fan into flame all the good gifts he gives us as we serve him this week!

Assisted Dying

Many of us will have seen or heard coverage in the news of the proposal by Kim Leadbetter MP to introduce legislation about Assisted Dying into the House of Commons.

Our Archbishops and some bishops have expressed deep concerns about what is being proposed from a Christian perspective, many of which will also concern us. Recognising of course that detailed proposals have yet to be debated and that this is a very complicated and sensitive issue around which there are many complexities, some of us may wish to find out more. Faithful Friday Blog Post from The Ven Andy Piggott for Friday 1st November

In just 5 days we've dipped into 4 different books of the bible this week ... and, perhaps surprisingly, I want to offer a thought based on a verse that we didn't even read, but one which might help us draw together some of the threads we've been thinking about! We've read Paul's final words to Timothy, an encouraging yet challenging letter to Titus and part of John's inspiring and mysterious vision of heaven in the book of Revelation.

On the feast day of Simeon and Jude on Monday we read *John 15:17-27* but the words of Jesus John records for us immediately beforehand in *v16* are really helpful. Jesus reminds us, 'You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit – fruit that will last.'

Paul, Timothy, Titus, Simeon, Jude, all the saints, **and that includes us (!!)**, have been chosen and called by Jesus ... and our purpose is to go and bear fruit! May God give us all a clear sense of his purpose, send his Spirit to fill us and use us as fruit bearers!

Diocesan News

On Wednesday 9th October, Bishop Martin was commissioned as the **Acting Bishop of Worcester**, a role which he will hold throughout the vacancy in See while continuing to be Bishop of Dudley. Bishop Martin wrote to clergy and lay leaders across the Diocese as he took up this new role. You can read his letter <u>via this link</u>. The process to find our next Bishop is well under way and you can read the diocesan Statement of Needs and see who our representatives will be on the Crown Nominations Committee <u>via this link</u>.

The diocese is planning a 'posada' during Advent this year with Mary and Joseph travelling around to a different church in the Diocese each day from 1st December. *Posada* is the Spanish word for lodging or accommodation, so each stop on this journey is their lodging for the night, representing the lodging places Mary and Joseph stayed at on their way to Bethlehem. It is hoped that several churches in our deanery will be involved. More details to follow.
