In the opening chapter of Matthew's gospel she is named within the family tree of Jesus (one of the five women in that tree); an honoured place for someone who chooses (as we read this week) to become a worshipper of the Lord. Praise God that His plans are fruitful.

# Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 12<sup>th</sup> January

*Matthew 22.* Have you noticed how the parables that Jesus tells in these chapters are not 'lovely fables with a moral message' where everyone lives happily every after? Instead he uses language and imagery that strike through to the heart and challenge long-held and settled religious opinions. The Pharisees and Sadducees strike back with their tricky questions, but Jesus uses each opportunity to lead them, and us, into a deeper understanding of living in God's long-term, eternal kingdom. What are we learning today?

The Archbishop of Canterbury, Justin Welby, will visit the Diocese on **Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> February** to bring us together in prayer. Prayer is the first of Archbishop Justin's stated priorities and as we continue to 'pray for growth' in our diocese. #### Week of Prayer for Christian Unity

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity takes place each year from the **18<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> January**. It provides an opportunity to focus our prayers on Christian unity, as well as speak about and experience Christian unity



personally, in our own locality, as well as engage with what happens at a national level. The theme for 2024 is: 'You shall love the Lord your God... and your neighbour as yourself' (Lk 10:27). It has come from an ecumenical team from Burkina Faso, facilitated by the local Chemin Neuf Community (CCN). They have reflected on the familiar story of the Good Samaritan, and all are encouraged to Go and do likewise. It is a story about crossing boundaries that calls our attention to the bonds that unite the whole human family. Brothers and sisters from the Catholic Archdiocese of Ouagadougou, Protestant Churches, ecumenical bodies and the CCN in Burkina Faso collaborated generously in drafting the prayers and reflections.
