

Baptism and Confirmation

After Easter I intend to draw together a group of adults (and possibly including older teenagers) who would like to prepare for **Baptism and Confirmation**, or just **Confirmation**, as appropriate. For an adult, **Confirmation** is the step of confirming their faith into which they were baptized as an infant or child. For some this is because of a recent reawakening of that faith. Where an adult has not previously been baptized **Baptism and Confirmation** are essentially one and the same step. In the Church of England **Confirmation** is also the gateway to full involvement in the service of **Holy Communion**, and this may also be a reason for joining the group. If you would like to join the group, or you have questions about the place where you are in your journey of faith, or about people of other ages, please get in touch with me. We'll arrange meeting times according to who is in the group.
