

Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 1st March

Genesis 45. The transformations we read about in earlier chapters are now seen to be in evidence amongst the wider family, not just in Joseph. They no longer have a cavalier attitude towards losing one of their brothers. They know they deserve judgement, but instead receive mercy, as again the story points us forward to how we receive the same through the cross of Jesus. Verse 5 shows how much Joseph has grown in his spiritual journey, and it has taken quite a number of years. We may pray for similar transformation, mercy and growth in our lives.



For the 820 members of the Christian community trapped inside Gaza's two churches, this means enduring more fear, hunger and grief as they struggle to survive. Christians in the West Bank have also suffered, losing their jobs and businesses due to the lack of tourists and border closures.
