Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd Andy Piggott for Friday 7th February

This week we've been reading parts of the last recorded long conversation Jesus had with his closest friends. They've had a 'final' meal together and this evening must have been a very emotional one. (Of course, in fact the last time Jesus ate with the disciples was a barbeque beach breakfast, but this took place after his resurrection (see John 21)). Jesus knew that soon he would be arrested and led out to die (13:1a), and although from time to time the disciples had understood some of what he'd told them, the penny hadn't fully dropped. Until the very end, Jesus's own description of them proved to be absolutely true ... they were so slow to understand. John sets the tone for much of what follows at the start of chapter 13. Having loved his own who were in the world, he now showed them the full extent of his love (13.1b). And as he washed the disciples' feet, tried to prepare them again for his departure, began to teach about the Holy Spirit and perhaps especially as he went willingly to the cross to die for our sins, he indeed showed the full extent of his love. Might this challenge us to consider how we too seek to show others something of the love of Jesus in our own lives?

KEP Parish Children's Club 2025


The Children's Club is a fun and friendly club for children aged 6 to 11 years (we can be slightly flexible on ages - please enquire). Lent & Holy Week 2025

You can now **book your place** for the **Christian Passover Meal** which will be held at **St Chad's** on **Maundy Thursday (17**th **April, 6:30 - 8:30 pm)** using the **sign-up sheets** in each church. Cost is £4 per person (children's price negotiable). We will use **Lent** to focus on preparing for the **Meal** by looking at the symbolism and ceremonies of the Passover to understand in a deeper way how Jesus re-crafted it to become something done "in remembrance of him", something that we now celebrate as Holy Communion. The **Lent Study sessions** will be weekly on **Tuesdays**, starting on **11**th **March**, at **St Cecilia's**, beginning with refreshments at 7:00pm (session starts 7:30pm). You do not have to come to the Meal to attend the Lent groups. *David*

Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd Andy Piggott for Friday 14th February

John continues to record for us further aspects of the 'Farewell Discourses' – the title sometimes given to this final conversation Jesus had with his close friends. There is much here for us to ponder as he tells them more about WHO the Holy Spirit is (nb NOT what!) and the particular work he does in the world and in the lives of those of us who love and follow Jesus. Whilst we might occasionally think, 'wouldn't it have been great to have met Jesus in the flesh?' and whilst the disciples certainly were very clear that they didn't want Jesus to leave them, Jesus himself stresses that it will be better for them when the Spirit comes. I think it's reasonable to assume that he'd say the same to us!

The emphasis on the Spirit in chapters 15 and 16 might seem a little disconnected from Jesus's teaching about 'the Vine', one of the most familiar of the famous 'I am' sayings in John's gospel – but there is in fact a strong connection! Jesus teaches about the relationship we have with him and his Father, our 'chosen-ness', the challenge of 'being pruned' and perhaps the even bigger challenge of our calling to be fruitful. You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit – fruit that will last (15.16).

May the Spirit work in and through us to make us fruitful in this coming week.
