Lent & Holy Week 2025

It might seem a long time ahead, but now is the time to start thinking about how you would like to get involved in **Lent** this year. We will be using **Lent** to prepare for a special event we are holding on **Maundy Thursday** (17th **April**) when we shall have **A Christian Passover Meal**. On that equivalent evening Jesus celebrated the Passover with his disciples, but re-crafted it to become something done "in remembrance of him", something that we now celebrate as Holy Communion. We will be looking at the symbolism and ceremonies to understand in a deeper way what Jesus has done for us. The meal on 17th April can include children (we'll begin around 6:30pm and end around 8:30pm). Our studies and preparations during Lent (on Tuesday evenings) will be aimed more at the adults who will be able to share at home with their children as appropriate. We'll need to take bookings for the meal, so watch out for the sign-up sheets in the coming weeks.

1 John 5. We might easily think that Paul is the only one who writes about Love because of his famous passage ("Love is patient, love is kind..."), but this set of readings brings to us John's incredibly practical understanding of Love: love in action. All that he writes arises from the desire that his readers will know that their faith in Jesus is concrete and that it results in eternal life as well as a practical love-based life here and now. His concern is that one disciple will help another to stay on track by prayer, by battling away on his behalf in the spiritual struggle that is our present experience. Can we manage to do that for each other?

Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 17th January


1 Corinthians 4. It is important to remember as we read through this letter that Paul begins it in chapter 1 with a declaration of how precious these young believers are to him, and how he thanks God for them. In subsequent chapters he has some strong words for them, chastises them for their attitudes and actions and lack of growth as disciples, but still he wants the best for them. In this chapter he employs sarcasm to make them sit up, "We are fools ... you are so wise ... We are weak, but you are so strong!" but he wants them back on track, back to living a life that shows they are "in Christ Jesus". Are there ways in which we can ensure those around us see we are "in Christ Jesus"?
