

John 21 We have travelled through Advent and Christmas Day has come and gone!! Perhaps you are wondering what it was all about? Today we celebrate St John, Apostle and Evangelist. In the Gospel of St John chapter 21 we find that the disciples were wondering too. Jesus had been crucified and the disciples were so lost as to what to do they returned to what they had known so well — fishing. Having fished all night they had caught nothing. It must have been salt in their wounds of grief. Then Jesus appears on the shore. Following his guidance they catch a huge number of fish. And then Jesus barbeques the fish for them and they see who he really is — Jesus risen from the dead. And he said to Peter "Follow me!" As the New Year approaches may 2025 be a year of glorious catches for you and may you follow Jesus more closely than ever before!

Faithful Friday Blog Post from Revd David Hildred for Friday 3rd January

John 1. Here we are in the last few days of the Christmas season before we slip into Epiphany and we read in this chapter (and tomorrow the next chapter) some revealing reactions to the arrival of Jesus. These reactions, of course, are no longer to the arrival of a baby, but to the start of the public ministry of the one who was given. There is John's deference to the Greater One, his repeated revelation of the Lamb of God, Andrew's response to the call, and his zeal in sharing that Jesus is the Messiah, Nathanael's surprise, and his declaration of worship. May this end of the Christmas season be full of our similar reactions.

 may the peace of Christ may be present over the Christmas period and beyond.
